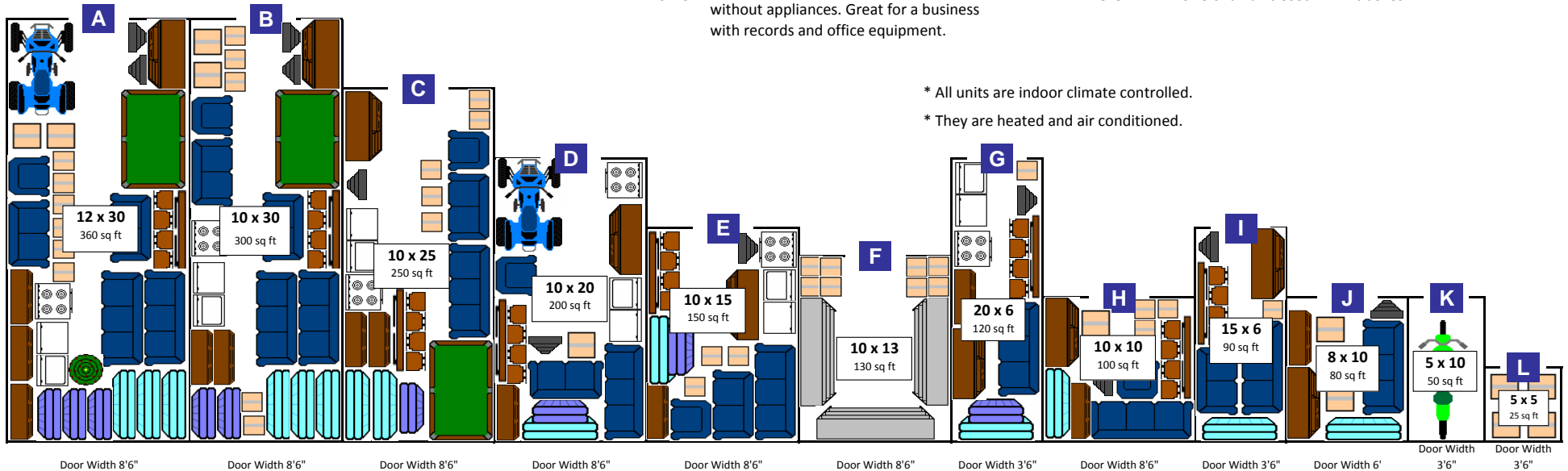


WHAT SIZE IS RIGHT FOR YOU?

Unit Sizing Guide

| A - 12x30 | Furnishings from a 4-5 bedroom house with appliances. Great for a small business. | G - 20x6 | Furnishings from a 1 bedroom apartment with lots of furniture. |
| B - 10x30 | Furnishings from a 3-4 bedroom house with appliances, patio furniture, and misc. items. | H - 10x10 | Furnishings from a 1 bedroom apartment. Comparable to a small bedroom. |
| C - 10x25 | Furnishings from a 2-3 bedroom house with appliances. Similar to a large one stall garage. | I - 15x6 | Furnishings from a small 1 bedroom apartment. |
| D - 10x20 | Furnishings from a 2-3 bedroom house with appliances. Similar to a one stall garage. | J - 8x10 | Furnishings from a studio apartment. |
| E - 10x15 | Furnishings 1-2 bedroom apartment furniture and appliances. Comparable to a large bedroom. | K - 5x10 | Size of a walk-in closet. Will hold boxes and some small furniture. Great for motorcycles. |
| F - 10x13 | Furnishings from 2 bedroom apartment without appliances. Great for a business with records and office equipment. | L - 5x5 | Size of a hall closet. Will fit boxes. |



All descriptions and sizes are approximate. The quantity of items any space will hold is dependent on a number of factors, including stacking ability and size of items. Remember to allow a little extra space for a middle aisle just in case you may need to locate a stored item in the future.
